



Eligibility Criteria for 2019 QFI Academy Applicants

Students from traditionally under-served, under-represented, rural, and/or lower socio- economical demographic areas of the United States. Income eligibility will be based on poverty and median guidelines from the U.S. Census Bureau. Need-based awards are determined by an internal matrix derived from the Federal Financial Standards to establish the estimated family contribution to the total cost of attendance.

We are also looking to recruit students who have the ability to continue their Arabic studies in their school or through enrollment in other Arabic programs.

QFI Scholar Application and Selection Process

Applicants are required to complete the MIL Qatar Foundation International Scholar Application, available for download on our website: www.middleburyinteractive.com/summer-language-academy. A copy of the application is below.

An internal registration is created for students selected for full and partial QFI scholarships, which provides them with an online account, without having to pay the tuition deposit. Applicants to the Academy are required to submit parent/guardian information, school information, language background, a recent grades report, and 300-word essay.

Completed applications for the QFI Scholarship will be reviewed on a weekly basis. The parent/guardian will be notified of final decisions by email by the deadline of the application. Scholarship awards will be issued to students who showed the greatest financial need and compelling reasons for pursuing Arabic language learning. Strong candidates exhibiting lesser financial need will be considered for partial QFI funding to offset the cost of tuition.

Students have one week from the date of the award letter to accept or decline the offer. If declined, the funds will be released to be re-awarded to another qualified applicant.
